





Bug Belly's never ending folding booklet

Start with a square of paper - ideally 297 x 297mm. Cut from an A3 sheet*.
If you use the Bug Belly designs from www.bugbelly.com print both front and back images. Trim the A3 sheet to make square and stick front to back.


*(a smaller square cut from A4 would be - 210 x 210mm)




1. Fold the sheet in half left to right, then in half again.



2. Open out, fold top to bottom, in half and half again.





6. Glue the two new squares and fold right side to middle and left side to middle.




